- Either a pair of jeans (skinny preferred), or a long skirt with leggings (if requested).

Items can be new, or gently used. Let us know the  
family size you want -- there are options for every  
budget. There are 350 tents/1800 people in this  
camp. They have received almost NO aid.

In addition to the two main items, the following is a list of other “optional” donations:

- Socks
- Underwear (new only, please!)
- Bra (sports bras are easiest)
- Sweater
- Fleece jacket or short winter coat
- Small pack of crayons per child plus paper. (One large pack ok for 3 or more children)  
\*new only please.
- A note or drawing from you to the family

Please **don't include anything other than what is listed here**. It is important that each tent get the same composition of donations. These people have literally nothing, and it hurts to see your neighbor getting what you don't have.

We are shipping a container from Detroit area to Greece **AT THE END OF AUGUST!**

So hurry and join us. Please consider asking your friends, neighbors, places of worship to **ADOPT-A-TENT** as well. Invite people to dinner and ask them to bring one thing to put into your bag. If it is your birthday month, think about forgoing presents for yourself and ask your friends to bring the needed items for your tent(s). Get your kids involved.
